

# Using Lua<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X to typeset RTL text with eledpar

## Abstract

This file provides an example on how to use eledpar and Lua<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X to typeset a right to left text with its translation on the facing page<sup>1</sup>.

As you can see, the switch to RTL convention is made *before* the **pstart**. It must be also called inside **\eledsection**.

For an example with X<sub>Y</sub><sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X, look at parallel-column-two-languages.tex file.
